Our interdependence globally implies a moral responsibility for human development; this, Pope Benedict writes, "*depends, above all, on a recognition that the human race is a single family working together in true communion, not simply a group of subjects who happen to live side by side.*"¹ those who benefit from the express and hidden advantages of racial inequities—still continuing—the Church urges honesty about the past and present so that everyone's future will be different. "An honest look at the past makes plain the need for restitution wherever possible—makes evident the justice of restoration and redistribution."²
