Reflection

A heart that seeks salvation. Not all the chief priests, teachers of the Scriptures, and elders were corrupt. Nicodemus was completely different. His heart sought the Truth. Yes, he was afraid of the opinion of the community that he belonged to so he came to Jesus under the cover of night. Jesus did not treat him harshly, did not point out his weaknesses, because he knew the righteousness of his heart. He does the same with us when, despite our mistakes in life, bad choices, and even great defeats in the face of temptation and sin, we come to Him in the "night of our life" with a heart that seeks help. We need to be pulled out of many of life's many confusing situations. The more we want to get out of them on our own (justifying and downplaying moral evil), the deeper we sink into them. Only Jesus can give us a hand, Jesus can come to our rescue. He came so that we might not perish in darkness, but that we might live eternal life.

Lord Jesus, thank you for today's word of hope. You love this world, even though it turns away from you so much. Take me by the hand and pull me out of the darkness, grasp my heart so that it will never again despise Your love. Amen.
