Reflection

Jesus sends his disciples to call for conversion, and for their journey He equips them with unique gifts: power over unclean spirits and the power to heal the sick. Healings of spirit and body are signs that confirm the power and importance of the Word they preach.

Disciples are to maintain an attitude of poverty, material things cannot burden them and cannot prevent them from freely proclaiming the Good News. The one who preaches the Gospel must be free internally, in other words, pure, and must remain free externally, that is, poor, dependent on the Father's providence, trusting in the power of the word he proclaims.

During the time Jesus walked on earth, holv haste was also important. The time of His public activity was very short, and there was a lot to convey. That is why the disciples had to devote themselves to the work of evangelization with such great commitment.
