Reflection

We have become accustomed to the fact that only one who has received 'special powers' from the Church can be a prophet (teacher) of God. In some situations this is of course necessary. But it cannot become an excuse for a "non-ordained" Christian (non-priest, non-catechist) not to feel obliged to participate in the prophetic mission of Christ and the Church. After all, we became obliged to do so by baptism. Therefore, it is worth noticing:

God willingly uses 'non-professionals'

God himself appropriately equips the one to whom he entrusts a mission (in other words He entrusted every baptized person!)

The 'one sent'; should focus on what is most important, not on creating appropriate conditions or providing support in the form of appropriate resources.

The 'one sent' is not to blame for being rejected. But is responsible when avoiding participating in the mission.

Taking responsibility for participating in a prophetic mission strengthens the preacher's faith.

How to accomplish this mission? There are always opportunities for this in the family. Often also in the workplace. If words are rejected, there is still the tool, that of one's own holy life ... and God will help.
