Bishop Nicholas is coming to install Fr James as the Parish Priest on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March at 5.00pm. After the Installation Mass, please join us and the Bishop in the school hall for refreshments and food. Please take this opportunity to pray with the Bishop for our new Parish Priest, and to be one of the first parishes to meet the Bishop in person.

### **Who is this priest?**

Seminary formation takes a little while. First is a two-year diploma in Philosophy which takes place in English at the Angelicum University, taught by Dominicans. Next comes theology, and owing to my earlier studies I received the Pontifical Baccalaureate in Sacred Theology, all taught in Italian, after one year at the Gregorian University with the Jesuits. Thanks to the extra time, I took the opportunity to have a pastoral placement year at Abbey Road, Torquay, with Fr Kieran Kirby RIP. This year also enabled me to have an Army Chaplaincy taster week before returning to Rome. What was I asked to do after that?
