Who is this priest?

Last week I shared with you my conversion and journey through university in London and my acceptance into seminary as a student of Westminster. The Cardinal decided to send me to the Venerable English College, Rome, the very same seminary that Canon George attended. When I arrived I was greeted by the Rector of the English College, one Fr Nicholas Hudson who has since become our Bishop. After my first year at the College I felt called to return to my home and transfer to the Plymouth Diocese. This was accepted by the Cardinal, Bishop Christopher, and Bishop Mark, as all three were involved at the time. The Rector at the time, Mgr. Philip Whitmore, described it as the easiest transition he'd ever witnessed as the Lord was clearly moving us. What happened next?
