### Who is this priest?

Last week I mentioned my first curacy in Barnstaple. Once I had finished my year there, I was sent to the great parish of St. Mary's, Poole which has a weekly Sunday attendance of more than 800. When Bishop Mark sent me there, he ordered me to develop the ministry to young people and to become Priest Chaplain of St Edward's Catholic/CofE Secondary School. I had never worked with teens in any capacity thus far but God's grace was ever at work. We turned the Confirmation Course into a space for all Youth from Year 7 to 13 and it still thrives to this day with many tens of young people exploring their faith every week. My chaplaincy at St Edward's included supporting the RE teaching team, supporting staff more broadly, but mainly working with students who had bigger struggles in life. During that time I also acquired a series of other roles in the Diocese which continue to this day. I was curate there for 2 ½ years until I became Priest-in-Charge of another parish. More to come next week!

On Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May, our neighbouring parish in Honiton are celebrating their patronal feast day and we're invited! There is a Mass at 12.00noon followed by a Blessing & Distribution of Roses for the sick. Later there is Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 3.00pm.
