### Mass Offering Envelopes

Last week I mentioned the new Mass Offering envelopes which is how you get a Mass said for someone, living or dead. I forgot to explain how to use them: fill out the information on the front, place your offering inside (suggested offering is £20, but only put in what you can afford even if it is zero), and then place the sealed envelope into the collection plate/bag. Your envelope will be opened and counted, then the information passed to the Parish Office. We may be in touch if your desired Mass time/date is not available.

### Altar Serving

Altar servers are essential to the worthy celebration of Sunday Mass and the more servers we have, the more beautiful we can make it. An altar server has an opportunity to support the community through their service, and to develop a deeper relationship to Jesus in the Eucharist by serving at His Table. Any children who have received their First Holy Communion are eligible and adults, especially parents, would be welcome to help lead as well but an application and a DBS check is required before beginning. Let me know if you would like to start whether now or in September.

### Home Communion Team

Our parish family includes a number of sick and housebound parishioners who are unable to come to church but receive Holy Communion at home. At present, we have a small number of dedicated Home Communion Team members, but we need to expand our Team. Ideally, we need four parishioners per church to meet the needs of our sick & housebound. Job Descriptions are available at the back of church – an enhanced DBS is required before starting, giving plenty of time for training and formation. If you are interested, please take a description and email the parish, or myself and we'll get the necessary forms to you.

### Plymouth Diocese Summer Camps

This annual gathering takes place 27<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> July at Buckfast Abbey for children aged 9-12. The theme of the residential will be Dilexi Te to reflect on God's love for us, it is underpinned by the scripture Revelations 3:9.
