Altar Serving

Altar servers are essential to the worthy celebration of Sunday Mass and the more servers we have, the more beautiful we can make it. Any children who have received their First Holy Communion are eligible and adults, especially parents, would be welcome to help lead as well but an application and a DBS check is required before beginning.
