### **Fr James – Licence in Canon Law**

Bishop Nicholas has instructed me to undertake a Licence in Canon Law, part-time and long-distance at the Pontifical University of Leuven, Belgium. A Licence is much like a Masters in that it includes lectures, essays, exams, and will conclude with a research paper and my delivering a lecture. This should begin sometime in September, and while it is not clear yet exactly what it involves, it will require a significant time commitment which I hope will become less as the Licence progresses. While this will likely mean that I am less available 'on tap' your pastoral care remains my primary responsibility, especially to the sick & housebound, and to children and their families. Please keep me in your prayers, but also pray that the Lord continues to move and empower members of our community to use their gifts and talents.
